Do Not Feed:

We would like to remind you that the rules and regulations state that you are not to feed the ducks and geese. Some of the negative effects are as follows.

- Lack of balanced diet may cause deformity in goslings, hindering the bird's flight ability.
- Feeding causes overcrowding allowing diseases such as botulism and cholera to spread easily and possibly result in massive waterfowl die-offs.
- · Geese lose their fear of humans and become aggressive.
- Feeding reduces the need for geese to migrate they stay in an area longer and create more problems.

Parking Violations:

We have noticed several issues with parking on the property, below are the most violations to date.

- There is no parking on the street or in the grass at any time.
- Town home residents may not use the parking provided for the Garden/Flat units.
- If you have a vehicle that has not driven for more than two weeks, it will be classified as abandoned and will be towed.
